Through maintaining the commitment to environmental initiatives and collaborating with charter companies, marinas, institutions, and environmentally conscious individuals, Green Sail has provided comprehensive and impactful educational materials.

Achievements

- Successfully launched our new (VEF) Vessel Environmental Footprint Program, an innovative new way for yacht charter companies to measure and reduce their environmental footprint
- Surpassed our target by delivering onboard education materials (Green Sail Flags, brochures and recycling stickers) to 1631 boats and distributing 20 marina flags
- Successfully launched an online Climate Change Course and guided 90 participants through our new Marine Sustainability Course on Thinkific and Seably
